Camp Arrowhead is located in the historic Columbia River Gorge. One of three resident camps in Girl Scouts of Oregon and Southwest Washington, this one has a focus of challenge. With a climbing wall, hiking trails, and many off-camp waterfall trips, Camp Arrowhead offers something for everyone. Arrowhead also offers canoeing, archery, and swimming in both the lake and the pool. While programs run grades K-12, the typical age is 4-8. Counselors sleep in their own cabin separate from the girls and have a staff house to relax in on time off.

After staff training, the typically work schedule is Sunday through Friday with a two hour break each day. Staff have Friday evening, all day Saturday, and Sunday mornings off.

Camp Cloud Rim sits at an elevation of 9,200 feet near Park City, nestled among aspen and pine on the shores of Lake Brimhall. Camp Cloud Rim has beautiful facilities; including a lodge and shower house, electricity, hot water, and flush toilets. Camp Cloud Rim serves girls aged 6-18. Girls live in cabins or platform tents with staff located nearby. Depending on the camp session, campers may participate in canoeing, sailing, kayaking, swimming, photography, pottery, rock climbing, hiking, and backpacking.

STAFF TIME OFF

Camp staff members at resident program delivery sites have two free hours each day. There is no set time frame for these rest periods. Camp staff members at resident program delivery sites are free from their duties at least 24 consecutive hours every seven days. Typically, staff are off on weekends from Saturday afternoon to Monday morning. There are a few weekends were staff will have to work and their time off will be flexed and or adjusted. The specific hours granted for rest periods will be determined by the Camp Director, taking into consideration staff members' requests and the program delivery site's requirements.

Camp Gallahue is a resident camp located in Southern Indiana. We serve girls ages 7 to 17 years old. Our camp runs from Sunday to Friday, with a break for the counselors over the weekend. We have eight units with each unit having a different theme each week. Some of the themes are: Harry Potter, Hunger Games, Color Wars, Percy Jackson, Tangled, Beach Party-Hawaiian Luau, and our most popular horse back riding sessions. We have a lake with canoeing, sailing, and kayaking. We are a primitive camp; which means we sleep in platform tents. We cook out a meal once a week, and hike everywhere we go. Each unit has about 36 girls with 4 or 5 counselors. We hire lifeguards, boating staff, and unit counselors. Our camp is large and you will walk about 2 to 3 miles a day. We have weekly all camp sessions like: counselor hunt, sponge (water) fights, Dutch auction, barn dances, movies in the amphitheater. We sing songs, have campfires, have a 4th of July parade and day of games and fireworks. Our main focus is for the girls to make friends, become adjusted to living in nature and having great memories to take home with them!

STAFF TIME OFF

Every staff gets 2 hours of break each day- Monday thru Thursday. Sunday and Friday you do not because those are the days the girls arrive and depart. Staff have Friday afternoon thru Sunday morning off. We leave camp once it is clean and plans for the next week have been made. Sunday we arrive back to camp by noon.
